



## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Exhibition Services & Contractors Association (ESCA) has developed a national Worker Identification System Program, called ESCA Badge, that allows entry into participating facilities by the contractor's workers who have been registered with the Program.

## **OVERVIEW**

ESCA maintains a complete database of all workers in a web-based program that is available to venue management and contractors 24/7.

The database is kept secure and accurate with real-time updates and monitoring.

Approved administrators can register new workers and renew existing records through the web-based portal.


