

## **Utah Live Events Industry Association Proposed Guidelines**

#### **Executive Summary**

### I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

The Utah Live Events Industry Association ("ULEIA") has reviewed the Phased Guidelines, an addendum to Utah Leads Together 2.0 ("Phased Guidelines," or "the Guidelines") and recommends that 1) the Guidelines incorporate case-by-case determined event specific capacities instead of blanket attendee limits; 2) the Guidelines include clarified seating and layout guidelines for temporary or configurable venues; and 3) that Health Departments across the state adopt a system of cooperative planning and approval for live events.

In order to fully understand the impact, the Guidelines were applied to and reviewed in relation to four event format types:

- A. **Static Events:** Events where the attendees primarily enter, watch, and depart
- B. Interactive Events: Events where attendees create a traffic flow and interact with each other
- C. **Participant Events:** Events where attendees primarily participate in an activity or production
- D. **Community Events:** Events with many activities and population centers and likely a random traffic pattern

### II. PROPOSED RISK PHASE GUIDELINES (P. 2-7)

As the Live Events Industry has been working to map the current Guidelines to our operations and events, we recommend that the following changes are made to ensure that the Live Events Industry can successfully ease restrictions while maintaining the safety of employees, performers and attendees.

## a. Case-by-Case Event Capacities, Layouts, and Traffic Patterns

- i. Facility Specifics: Capacities must be set in relation to size and layout.
- ii. Traffic Patterns: Total attendance or participation is not an indication of the attendees on site at any one time and proper traffic pattern control process can be implemented.
- iii. Seating and Layout: Fixed and Temporary venues will use similar guidelines to separate and distance.
- iv. Multi-Centered Events: Events with multiple activities or population centers should permitted with each event (e.g., County Fairs, 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebrations, etc.).

Current practices and guidelines in place for Supermarkets, Home Improvement Stores and soon to be in place for retail establishments and restaurants should also be applicable to events if event organizers can meet or exceed these guidelines. In addition, the special rules provided for the operation of Farmers Markets is very applicable to many event formats.
